

1.1 Senator ..... moves to amend S.F. No. 3243 as follows:

1.2 Page 2, after line 7, insert:

1.3 "Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 123B.595, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.4 Subd. 2. **Long-term facilities maintenance revenue for a charter school.** (a) For fiscal  
1.5 year 2017 only, long-term facilities maintenance revenue for a charter school equals \$34  
1.6 times the adjusted pupil units.

1.7 (b) For fiscal year 2018 only, long-term facilities maintenance revenue for a charter  
1.8 school equals \$85 times the adjusted pupil units.

1.9 (c) For fiscal year 2019 and later, long-term facilities maintenance revenue for a charter  
1.10 school equals \$132 times the adjusted pupil units.

1.11 (d) For fiscal years 2020 to 2027 only, long-term facilities maintenance revenue for a  
1.12 charter school is increased by \$100 times the adjusted pupil units."

1.13 Page 2, after line 25, insert:

1.14 "Sec. 4. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 123B.595, subdivision 10, is amended to read:

1.15 Subd. 10. **Allowed uses for long-term facilities maintenance revenue.** (a) A district  
1.16 may use revenue under this section for any of the following:

1.17 (1) deferred capital expenditures and maintenance projects necessary to prevent further  
1.18 erosion of facilities;

1.19 (2) increasing accessibility of school facilities;

1.20 (3) health and safety capital projects under section 123B.57; or

1.21 (4) by board resolution, to transfer money from the general fund reserve for long-term  
1.22 facilities maintenance to the debt redemption fund to pay the amounts needed to meet, when  
1.23 due, principal and interest on general obligation bonds issued under subdivision 5.

1.24 (b) A charter school may use revenue under this section for any purpose related to the  
1.25 school, except that, for fiscal years 2020 to 2027 only, the additional revenue under  
1.26 subdivision 2, paragraph (d), must be used to increase the safety and security of students  
1.27 and staff."

1.28 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references

1.29 Amend the title accordingly
