

1.1 Senator ..... moves to amend S.F. No. 1148 as follows:

1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. **ESTABLISHMENT OF A PRIVATIZED STATE-BASED**  
1.4 **MARKETPLACE.**

1.5 Subdivision 1. **Establishment.** The MNsure Board and executive director, in consultation  
1.6 with the commissioners of commerce and human services, and the chief information officer  
1.7 of MN.IT, shall develop a request for proposal (RFP) for a private vendor to operate the  
1.8 technology functionality for the individual market and the small business health options  
1.9 program (SHOP) currently provided by MNsure. The privatized state-based marketplace  
1.10 shall take the place of MNsure, established under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 62V, beginning  
1.11 July 1, 2018. The privately run system shall use existing "off the shelf" products if available.  
1.12 The system must provide core functions, including the determination of eligibility for  
1.13 advanced premium tax credits and cost-sharing reductions under Code of Federal Regulations,  
1.14 title 45, section 155.305, paragraphs (a), (f), and (g), enrollment into individual health plans,  
1.15 consumer outreach and assistance, and the ability for consumers to compare and choose  
1.16 different individual health plans or small group health plans that contain a variety of premium  
1.17 and cost-sharing options. The system must have account transfer capabilities that are  
1.18 compatible with the eligibility and enrollment system for the medical assistance and  
1.19 MinnesotaCare programs maintained by the Department of Human Services, and must  
1.20 provide an individual who may be eligible for medical assistance or MinnesotaCare the  
1.21 ability to connect with the health plan options available through these programs.

1.22 The system must incorporate, where appropriate and cost-effective, elements of the  
1.23 MNsure eligibility determination system.

1.24 Subd. 2. **Implementation plan; draft legislation.** The commissioner of human services,  
1.25 in consultation with the commissioner of commerce, the chief information officer of MN.IT,  
1.26 and the MNsure Board, shall develop and present to the 2018 legislature an implementation  
1.27 plan for conversion to a privatized state-based marketplace. The plan must include draft  
1.28 legislation for any changes in state law necessary to implement the new marketplace,  
1.29 including, but not limited to, necessary changes to Laws 2013, chapter 84, and technical  
1.30 and conforming changes related to the repeal of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 62V.

1.31 Subd. 3. **Federal approval.** The commissioner of human services shall seek all necessary  
1.32 federal waivers to ensure that advanced premium tax credits and cost-sharing reductions  
1.33 remain available for Minnesota and shall seek all federal grants and funds available for  
1.34 planning and development costs.

2.1       Sec. 2. **APPROPRIATION.**

2.3 commissioner of human services to prepare the request for proposal and to contract with a  
2.4 vendor as required under section 1.

2.8 January 1, 2019."
