

1.1 Senator ..... moves to amend S.F. No. 2092 as follows:

1.2 Page 2, line 15, delete "Biennial referendum on fees to raise revenues" and insert  
1.3 "Five-year renewal; reverse referendum"

1.4 Page 2, line 17, delete everything after "for"

1.5 Page 2, line 18, delete everything before the comma and insert "up to a five-year period"

1.6 Page 3, delete lines 3 to 14 and insert:

1.7 "(d) Following publication and before imposing the fee, the municipality must provide  
1.8 an opportunity at its next regular meeting for public comment relating to the issue. No  
1.9 sooner than 90 days after the public comment opportunity, the municipality may proceed  
1.10 with imposing the fee, unless a petition is filed as provided in paragraph (e).

1.11 (e) Within 90 days after the meeting held by the municipality at which public comment  
1.12 was accepted, a petition requesting a referendum may be filed with the chief clerical officer  
1.13 of the municipality. The petition must be signed by at least five percent of the registered  
1.14 voters in the municipality. The petition must meet the requirements of the secretary of state,  
1.15 as provided in section 204B.071, and any rules adopted to implement that section. If the  
1.16 petition is sufficient, the question of whether the municipality may impose a fee that raises  
1.17 revenue as provided in subdivision 1 must be placed on the ballot at the next general election.  
1.18 If a majority of the voters voting on the question votes in favor of using the fee to raise  
1.19 revenue, the municipality may proceed with imposing the fee.

1.20 (f) If a license, permit, right, or franchise agreement is entered into or renewed before  
1.21 August 1, 2017, and by its terms and the ordinance authorizing it, will be in effect after  
1.22 August 1, 2022, the municipality must follow the procedures in this subdivision to provide  
1.23 notice, a public hearing, and opportunity for a petition for a referendum by August 1, 2022.

1.24 (g) Except as provided in paragraph (f), this subdivision applies to a license, permit,  
1.25 right, or franchise agreement entered into or renewed on or after August 1, 2017."
