Dear Senator Kiffmeyer and Representative O'Driscoll;

As you know, the Governor's appointment of members to the Campaign Finance and Public Disclosure Board requires the advice and consent of both the House of Representatives and the Senate. Confirmation requires consent from three-fifths of the members of each body, and must occur by the end of the 45<sup>th</sup> legislative day, or by adjournment sine die, whichever occurs first.

This year five of the six members of the Board are before your committees for confirmation hearings. Below is a table of the members who require confirmation, their party affiliation, and the end of the term of their appointment. Enclosed you will find a packet of information for each member, including a short biography and copies of the open appointment application, any cover letter or resume submitted with the application, the most recent economic interest statement, and the notice of appointment from the Governor.
