

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 1386 as follows:

1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 122A.26, subdivision 2, is amended to
1.4 read:

1.5 Subd. 2. **Exceptions.** (a) A person who teaches in a community education program
1.6 which qualifies for aid pursuant to section 124D.52 shall continue to meet licensure
1.7 requirements as a teacher. A person who teaches in an early childhood and family
1.8 education program which is offered through a community education program and which
1.9 qualifies for community education aid pursuant to section 124D.20 or early childhood
1.10 and family education aid pursuant to section 124D.135 shall continue to meet licensure
1.11 requirements as a teacher. A person who teaches in a community education course which
1.12 is offered for credit for graduation to persons under 18 years of age shall continue to
1.13 meet licensure requirements as a teacher.

1.14 (b) A person who teaches a driver training course which is offered through a
1.15 community education program to persons under 18 years of age shall be licensed by the
1.16 Board of Teaching or be subject to section 171.35. A license which is required for an
1.17 instructor in a community education program pursuant to this ~~subdivision~~ paragraph shall
1.18 not be construed to bring an individual within the definition of a teacher for purposes of
1.19 section 122A.40, subdivision 1, or 122A.41, subdivision 1, clause (a).

1.20 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for the 2016-2017 school year and
1.21 later.

1.24 Subdivision 1. **Staff development committee.** (a) A school board must use the
1.25 revenue authorized in section 122A.61 for:

1.26 (1) teacher development and evaluation plans under section 122A.40, subdivision 8,
1.27 or 122A.41, subdivision 5;

1.28 (2) principal development and evaluation under section 123B.147, subdivision 3;

1.29 (3) in-service education programs under section 120B.22, subdivision 2; and

1.30 (4) other staff development needs.

1.31 (b) The board must establish an advisory staff development committee to develop
1.32 the plan, assist site professional development teams in developing a site plan consistent
1.33 with the goals of the plan, and evaluate staff development efforts at the site level. A
1.34 majority of the advisory committee and the site professional development team must be

2.1 teachers representing various grade levels, subject areas, and special education. The
 2.2 advisory committee must also include nonteaching staff, parents, and administrators.
 2.3 "Teacher" under this section includes all individuals classified as teachers under section
 2.4 179A.03 or section 122A.61.

 2.6 later."
