

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 3343 as follows:

1.2 Page 1, after line 22, insert:

1.3 "Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 123B.41, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

1.4 Subd. 5. **Individualized instructional or cooperative learning materials.**

1.5 "Individualized instructional or cooperative learning materials" means educational materials
1.6 which:

1.7 (a) are designed primarily for individual pupil use or use by pupils in a cooperative
1.8 learning group in a particular class or program in the school the pupil regularly attends,
1.9 including teacher material that accompanies materials for pupil use;

1.10 (b) are secular, neutral, nonideological and not capable of diversion for religious use;
1.11 and

1.12 (c) are available, used by, or of benefit to Minnesota public school pupils.

1.13 Subject to the requirements in clauses (a), (b), and (c), "individualized instructional or
1.14 cooperative learning materials" include, but are not limited to, the following if they do not
1.15 fall within the definition of "textbook" in subdivision 2: published materials; periodicals;
1.16 documents; pamphlets; photographs; reproductions; pictorial or graphic works; prerecorded
1.17 video programs; prerecorded tapes, cassettes and other sound recordings; manipulative
1.18 materials; desk charts; games; study prints and pictures; desk maps; models; learning kits;
1.19 blocks or cubes; flash cards; individualized multimedia systems; prepared instructional
1.20 computer software programs; choral and band sheet music; electronic books and other
1.21 printed materials delivered electronically; and CD-Rom.

1.22 "Individualized instructional or cooperative learning materials" do not include
1.23 instructional equipment, instructional hardware, or ordinary daily consumable classroom
1.24 supplies."
