I am very disappointed in the unfairness of the stabilization grants. I am thankful for the help but really feel like Family (home) Child Care Providers did not get a fair share. I do not have employees, I work alone, which makes it even more difficult for me to stay open during this trying time. I had a family out for two weeks recently and today received the call that another family would be gone for ten days. I have just lost two children to parents at home. Many child care providers will not survive this even with \$430/month grant. Our costs continue to go up at a faster pace than we can raise rates for our families. Center may have more employees but they also charge way more than I do. It seems that centers are taken care of way more than homes. I'm afraid for the future of my business and I'm afraid for my health as I take a risk every day caring for children. I hope you will reconsider the distribution of these grants to get enough help to everyone.
