Thank you for the information provided an for advocating for your student-athlete.

Based on what we've received, the application for review would remain incomplete. Here is information as to why the status remains incomplete:

- Premise of the transfer was for in-person learning which has consistently been determined as unexceptional.
- The family made a decision they believe was best for their child knowing they would not be eligible at the varsity level.
- Medical health care's expertise noticed that the change of setting was beneficial **after** the transfer had already occurred. (March of '21)
- Not having another level of competition in a sport has not warranted a review the Eligibility Committee.

We continue to seek ways in which student-athletes are eligible to compete. We also need to show consistency in how we process more than 50 plus applications. I believe we have done so [Redacted], but we also know it doesn't work for some of our family situations.
