I don't know what data has been put together to support and communicate the decision (not asking to review it). Sounds like he is starting to get a lot of push back. Specifically, he is wondering if we can help connect the dots between attending a youth sporting event and then showing up for work at a LTC facility, or going to the bar and then to work at LTC. First Lady asked if we had data or could help communicate the similarity between attending a youth sporting event to having an extended dinner at a restaurant or to musical events (time unmasked, laughing, talking loudly). May just be a communications need rather than data, but checking.
