Bill Description

SF 1444 would extend the license expiration date for all teaching licenses set to expire June 30, 2021 to December 30, 2021.

Assumptions

This extension, which was also provided for licenses expiring in June 30, 2020, merely delayed processing of licensure renewal applications. No cost, at that time, was required to indicate on the “Educator License Lookup” system that the licenses were extended 6 months. The license renewal fees that would have been collected by June 30 were still collected but moved to the next fiscal year. Of the average of 18,000 renewal applications per year, approximately 3,000 renewals used the extension and renewed in FY 2021 instead of FY 2020. The fiscal note assumes a similar number will delay this year. At \$57 per application fee, this will delay approximately \$171,000 in general fund revenue expected in FY21 to be received in FY22.
