

1.1 Senator moves to amend the delete-everything amendment (SCS2995A-2)
1.2 to S.F. No. 2995 as follows:

1.3 Page 102, line 19, delete "lack of physical"

1.4 Page 102, delete line 20

1.5 Page 110, after line 15, insert:

1.6 "Subd. 6. **Emergency.** "Emergency" means a period when replacement staff are not able
1.7 to report for duty for the next shift or a period of increased patient need because of unusual,
1.8 unpredictable, or unforeseen circumstances, including but not limited to an act of terrorism,
1.9 a disease outbreak, adverse weather conditions, or a natural disaster that impacts continuity
1.10 of patient care."

1.11 Renumber the subdivisions in sequence

1.12 Page 118, after line 2, insert:

1.13 "(b) A core staffing plan does not apply during an emergency and a hospital is not out
1.14 of compliance with its core staffing plan during an emergency. A nurse may be required to
1.15 accept an additional patient assignment in an emergency."

1.16 Page 118, line 3, delete "(b)" and insert "(c)"

1.17 Page 118, delete subdivisions 4 and 6

1.18 Renumber the subdivisions in sequence

1.19 Page 118, line 28, delete "or" and insert a comma and before the period, insert ", or
1.20 prospective patient"

1.21 Page 121, line 19, delete "and"

1.22 Page 121, line 20, delete the period and insert "; and"

1.23 Page 121, after line 20, insert:

1.24 "(11) number of inpatient psychiatric units."

1.25 Page 122, line 13, after "nurse" insert "reasonably"

1.26 Page 122, line 14, delete ", in the nurse's judgment,"

1.27 Page 122, line 25, delete "shall" and insert "may" and after "section" insert "by issuing
1.28 a compliance order under section 177.27, subdivision 4"
