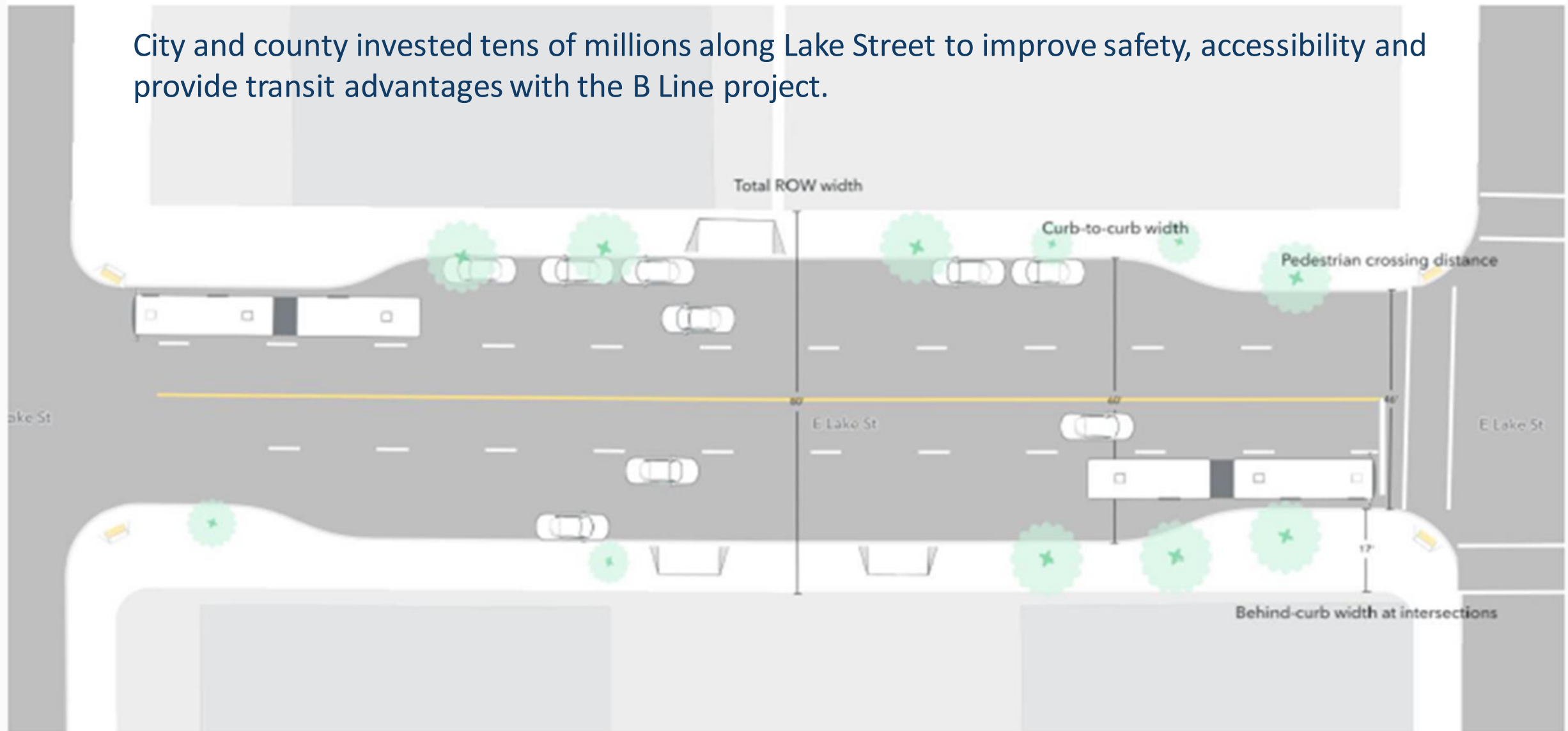


# When we can, local agencies step up to ensure ABRT success



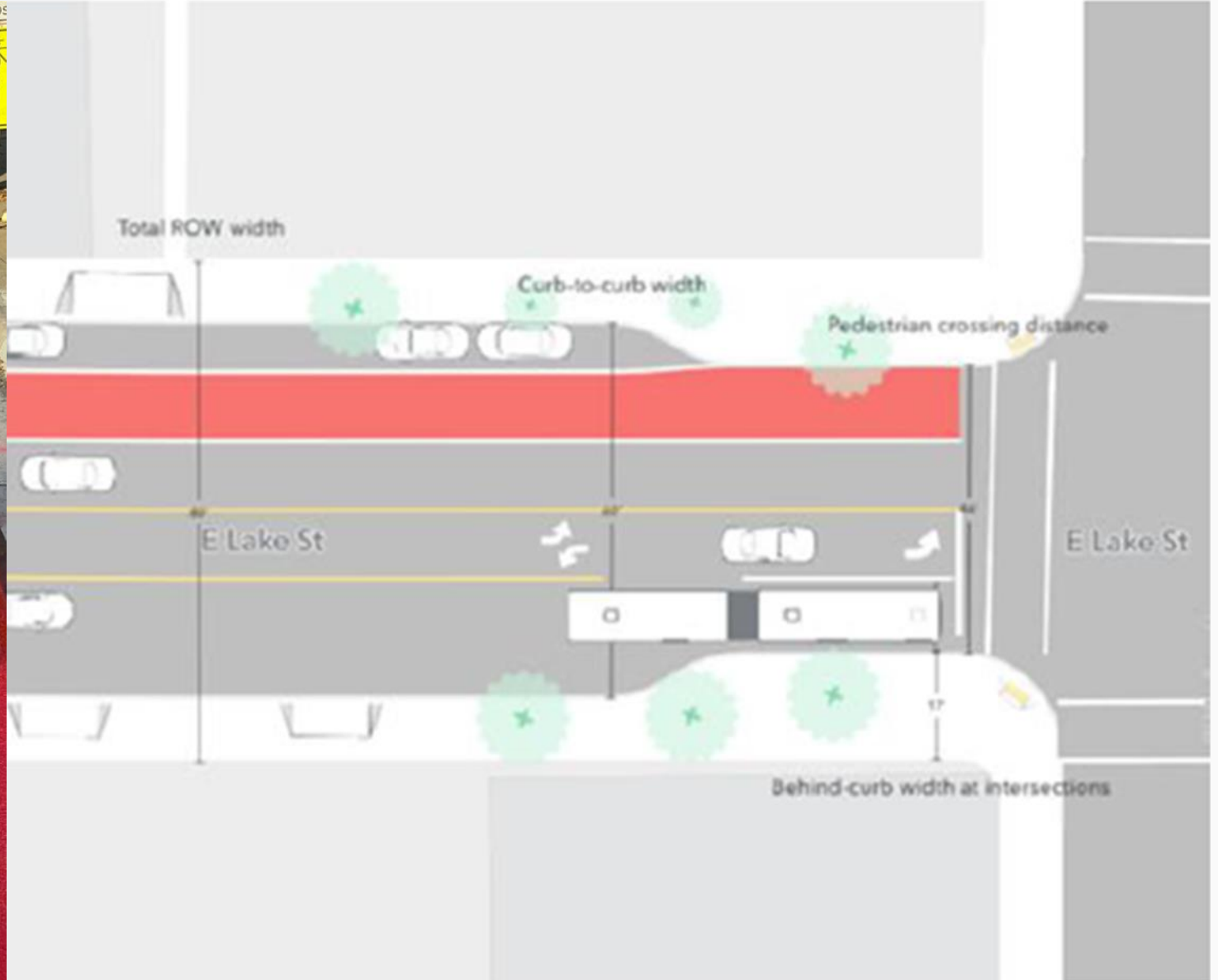
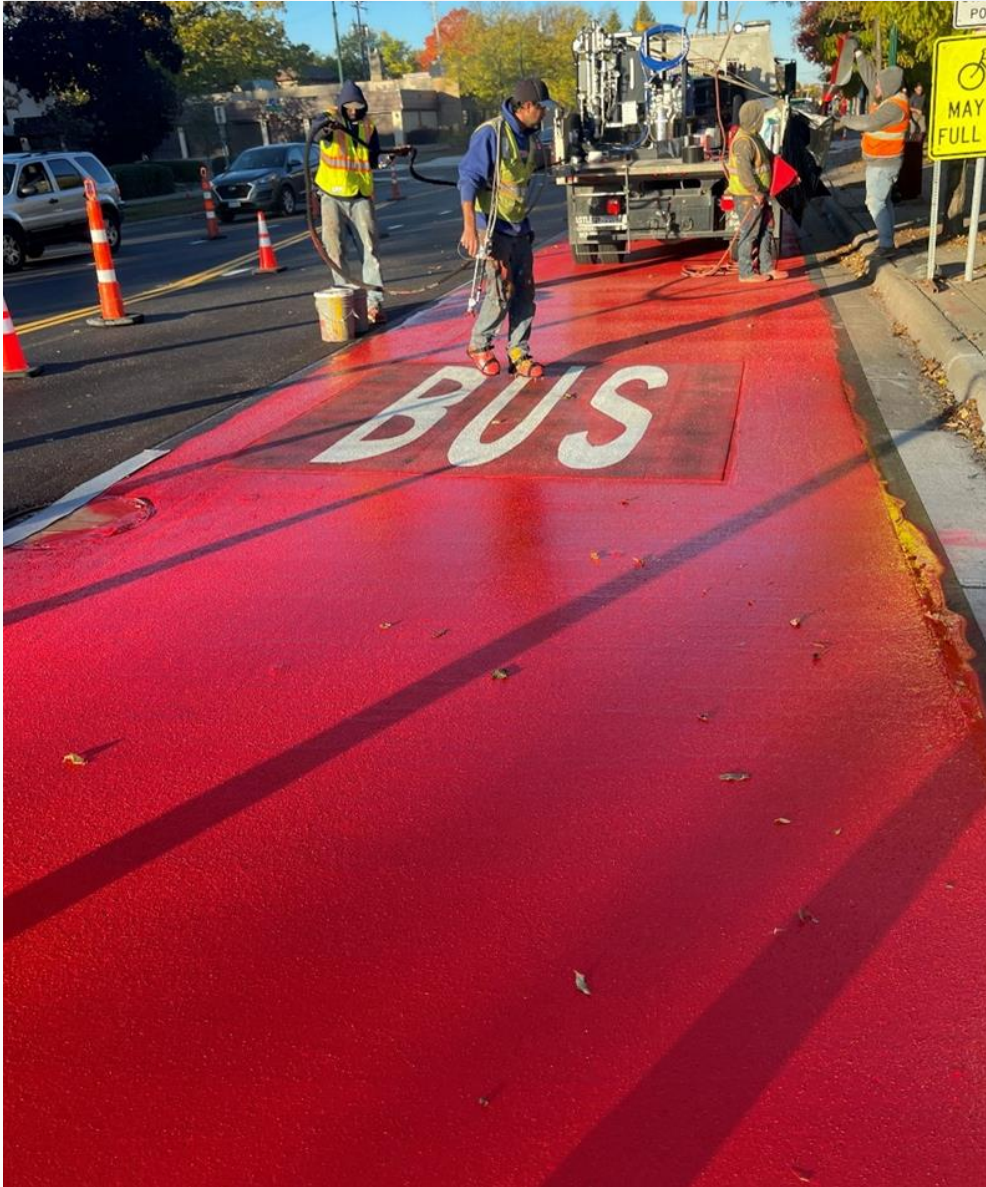
# Lake Street corridor – current configuration

City and county invested tens of millions along Lake Street to improve safety, accessibility and provide transit advantages with the B Line project.

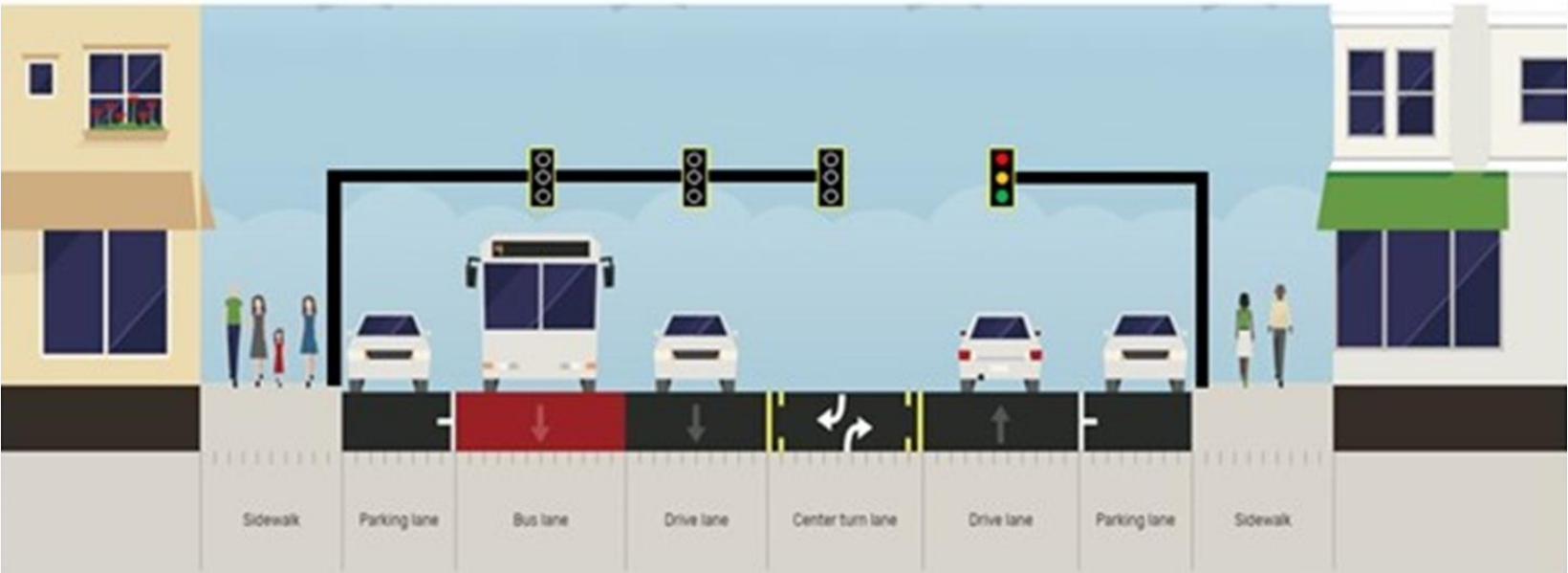
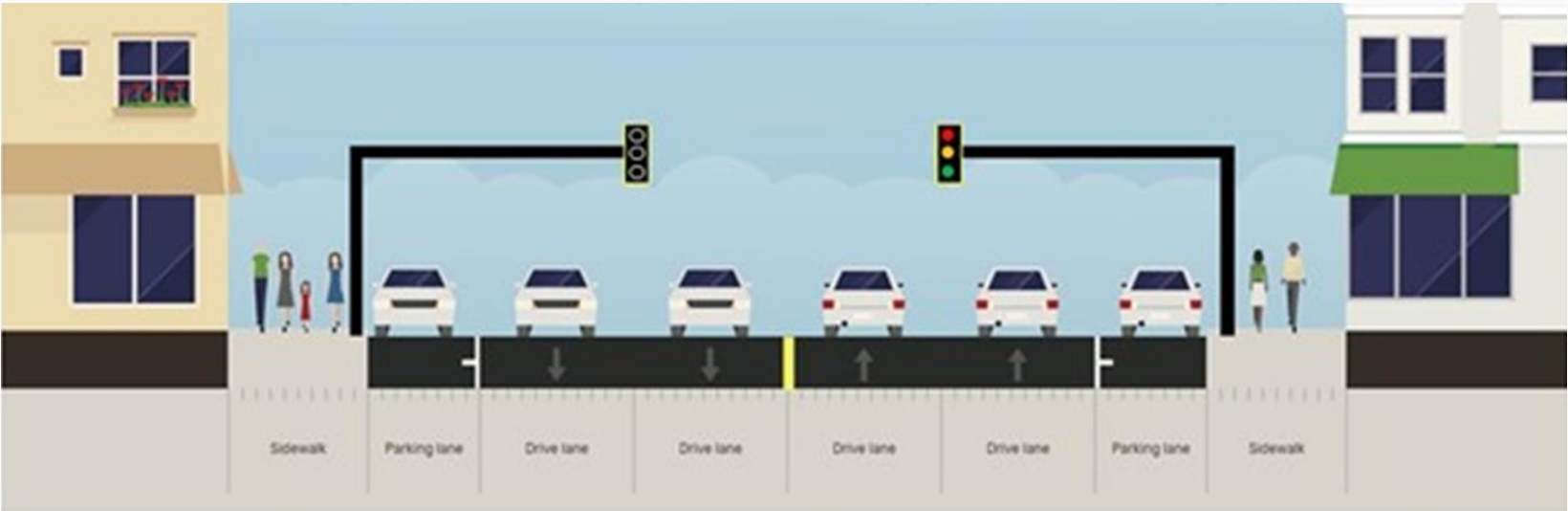




# Lake Street- bus priority lanes
