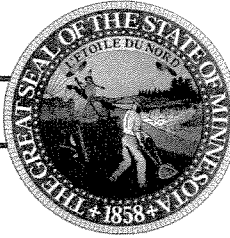

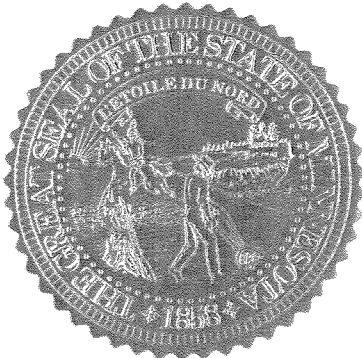

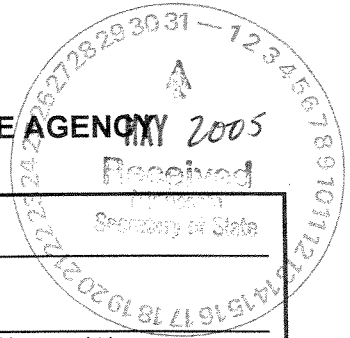

Adept at involving local institutions in the creation of complex artistic presentations that succeed within required time and budget constraints.
