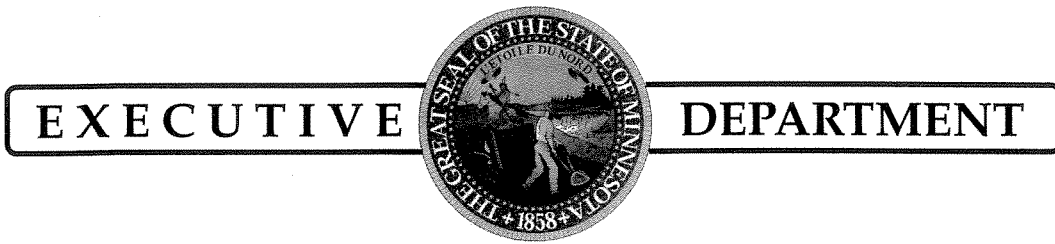



Kris Sanda is a former State Commissioner for Governor Arne Carlson, 1991-1999. As Commissioner of the Minnesota Department of Public Service for eight years, she supervised a \$54 million budget and a staff of 140 state employees who regulated electric, gas and telephone services. While in this position, she often testified before the U.S. Congress on various matters concerning the future of the nuclear industry and long-range national energy strategies.

Kris has served in five state administrations: Governor Al Quie, Governor Rudy Perpich, Governor Arne Carlson, Governor Jesse Ventura and Governor Tim Pawlenty. For Governor Quie, she was the Director of the Office of Consumer Services, and was the consumer advocate for the State of Minnesota from 1979-1983. In 1984 she was appointed by Governor Perpich as one of the first Racing Commissioners and assisted in writing the rules used to launch the racing industry in the Upper Midwest's Canterbury Downs racetrack. She has served on the Minnesota Board of Medical Practice for Governors Ventura and Pawlenty.

A teacher by training, she received her education at St. Cloud State University and the Hubert Humphrey Institute of Public Affairs at the University of Minnesota. She has also attended Michigan State University and short courses at Harvard University on regulation of utilities. Early in her career, she lived in Staples, Minnesota where she was a substitute high school teacher. She is the mother of six children and eleven grandchildren and a native of Detroit Lakes.

She is currently President of the Minnesota Lutheran Social Service Foundation and a Consumer Director of the Medica Board of Directors. Kris is the vice-president of the St. Paul American Red Cross and is a member of the City of Blaine's Transportation Committee and the Metropolitan Council's Transportation Advisory Board (TAB). A frequent political panelist on Twin Cities Public Television's "Almanac", Kris was the original Republican on the political panel beginning in 1985. A veteran Republican officer, she was a national delegate for Minnesota for two national conventions and was elected at various times in her career to every leadership position in the Minnesota Republican party from precinct to the state level. She was the first woman to head a committee for a National Republican Convention and is an experienced public speaker.

Her past duties have included being treasurer of the St. Paul Rotary club, Chairman of the State Employees Combined Charities campaigns for eight years, member of the St. Paul United Way board, member of the Industrial Relations Council at the Carlson School of Management University of Minnesota, member of the Minnehaha Park Restoration Committee, Minneapolis; Sons of Norway Oslo #2 Lodge, Minneapolis;

and Board member for Rasmussen Business Colleges. She is a past member of the Blaine Open Space 2000 Committee, which resulted in a successful \$4 million bond referendum.

Kris is the past chairman of the alumni board at the Humphrey Institute, University of Minnesota. Kris owns property in Anoka County and in Otter Tail County, Minnesota and belongs to Christ Lutheran Church (ELCA) of Blaine, Minn. and is a founding member of the newly created Growth and Justice Coalition.
