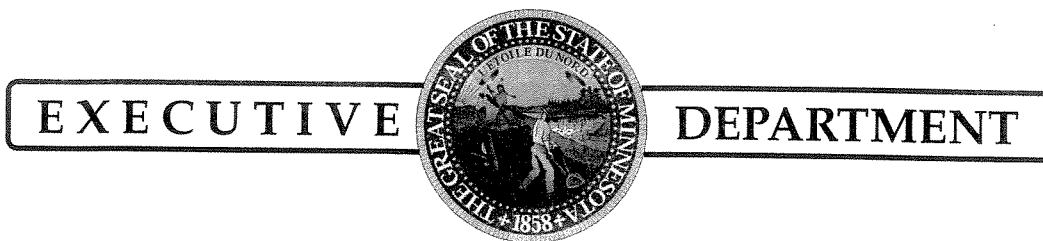



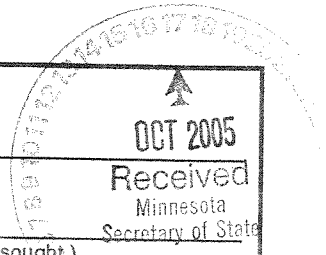

I have worked extensively with legislators of both political parties at the local, state and national level, testifying before both state and national congressional committees concerning issues I feel are important to veterans.


My background includes six plus years in the US Army, serving twenty-five months as a combat veteran in Vietnam. Employed by the Department of Economic Security, I served in the Brainerd office as a Disabled Veterans Outreach representative, with emphasis on employing and working with disabled veterans. I was employed as office manager for Minnesota Stihl and Northcentral Outdoor Equipment, a lawn and garden distributor located in Brainerd. While there I was promoted to district sales manager for Northcentral Outdoor Equipment, then general sales manager for North Star Outdoor Equipment encompassing distribution in nine states. Lastly, I was employed nine years as a division manager for Anderson Brothers Construction, retiring to pursue a national office for the Military Order of the Purple Heart, a veteran's service organization.

Veteran's service organization accomplishments include election to National Commander of the Military Order of the Purple Heart from August 02 to August 03. Currently I am a director on the Military Order of the Purple Heart National Service Foundation board. This year I became actively involved in the Disabled American Veterans and was elected as Department Jr. Vice Commander, Department of Minnesota (DAV).

Currently I serve in the following capacities: Commissioner vice president on the Brainerd Public Utilities Board, responsibilities include oversight of the management and operation of the facilities, budgeting, setting the rate structures, and monitoring the financial and cash flow data of this municipal utility. Chairman of the Big Island Veterans Camp Board - Lake Minnetonka, working with the leaders of the four major Veteran Service Organizations and the commissioner, together we are turning a potential liability into an asset that will enhance Minnesota veteran's quality of life for generations.

My leadership experience with sales management, construction management, and national veteran's service has enhanced my communication skills at all levels. Based on this experience, I have a proven track record of working efficiently and effectively in a fast paced environment, finding ways to solve problems, meeting the varied and often difficult demands of my customers and constituents, while being flexible enough to address problems as they arise. Throughout my career, I have worked well with management, employees, legislative personnel, and public officials, at all levels. I feel my background would be an asset to the board and the Minnesota veteran's community.
