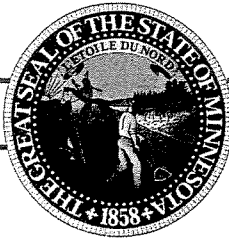

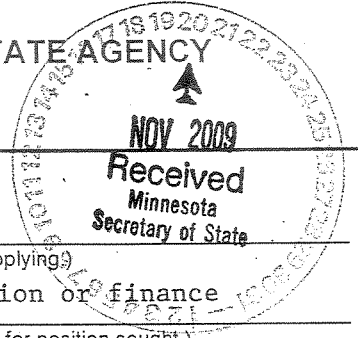

Enclosed is my application for reappointment as a member of the Board of the Minnesota State Academies. I have served on the Board since Fall 2004. Learning the policies and the procedures of the Board has taken some time, and I believe an additional term of service would maximize my effectiveness as a member of this governing body.

As a teacher at the Minnesota School for the Deaf from 1977-1984, I developed a loyalty to and love for the Academies. Since that time, my career path has afforded me numerous experiences that would be beneficial in an advisory capacity. I maintain a deep and abiding interest in the Academies. Below, I have highlighted those qualifications that support my candidacy for the Board.

From 1985-1997, I served as Coordinator of the Deaf/Hard of Hearing Program for Minneapolis Public Schools. My administrative experience in budgetary issues and program policy development would be an asset to the board. Given my experiences in special education and regular education, I have a good understanding of the full continuum of services needed to appropriately serve children with sensory impairments. This is a time of shrinking resources for education. I believe that I could assist the board in making wise decisions about the utilization of limited assets.

Since 1997, I have worked collaboratively for the University of Minnesota and Minneapolis Public Schools managing grants from the U.S. Department of Education. I have coordinated several special projects, including teacher training initiatives in the areas of multiple disabilities, English Language Learners, and preparing teachers for rural settings. I have learned first-hand about the changing face of Minnesota's schools and the challenges of providing appropriate services to an increasingly diverse student body. I believe my specialized knowledge of teacher education and professional development issues would be helpful to the Academies.

I have a special interest in educational technology. The attached resume' details my PT3 grant activities, "Preparing Tomorrow's Teachers to Use Technology". I have worked nationally with other college faculty to explore ways that technology can improve outcomes for students who are deaf or hard of hearing.

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
