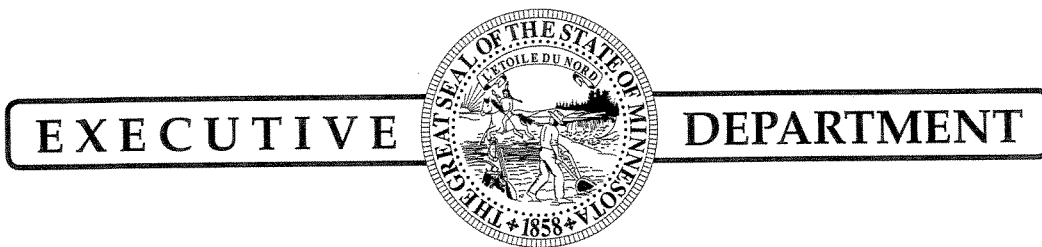



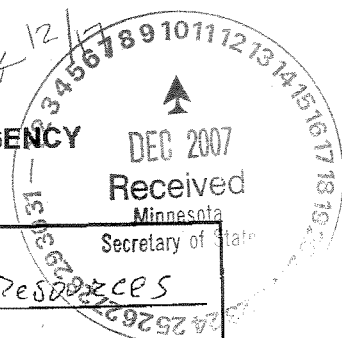

Nancy Gibson has won two Emmys for appearances and contribution to the award-winning PBS show *Newton's Apple*. In addition, the Minnesota Waterfowl Association gave her their "Conservationist of the Year" award for 2002 and she won the DFL Willard Munger Award for Environmental Stewardship in April of 2005. First Lady Mary Pawlenty recognized Nancy as one of Minnesota's most "Notable Women" in June 2006 for her work on behalf of the environment. Her proudest achievement is co-founding the International Wolf Center that opened its doors in 1993 after fundraising close to \$2 million dollars of public and private support. That effort was noted by then Governor Arne Carlson who appointed her as chair to the Minnesota Citizen Advisory Committee of the Environment and Natural Resources Trust Fund, a position held for 14 years. Nancy co-led the successful statewide constitutional campaign to re-dedicate lottery funds for 25 years to this Trust Fund beginning in 2000. She is currently co-vice chair of the new Legislative Citizens Commission on Minnesota Resources.

She also makes regular appearances as the naturalist for the NBC affiliate KARE TV and WCCO AM, is a part-time consultant for the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, a spokesperson on national and local media and a variety of jobs with wildlife-related organizations and issues. A close associate of wolf expert, Dr. L. David Mech, Nancy travels around the U.S. and abroad to work on and speak about wolf and other wildlife issues including her participation in reintroducing wolves to Yellowstone National Park and Idaho in 1995 and 1996. She spent the summers of 1992, 1993 and part of 2006 in Ellesmere Island observing and living with wild Arctic wolves. Nancy has been guiding wolf and wildlife trips in the Arctic and Yellowstone for the past decade. Nancy writes for *International Wolf*, wrote her first book in 1996 titled, *Wolves*, and has been a national guest columnist and book editor.

Her studies and strong interest have taken her to every continent from mountain gorilla observation in Africa, polar bear research to catching and tagging lynx in northern Minnesota. In addition, she worked with cougars in New Mexico, Gray whales in Mexico, and tagging deer fawns and bald eagles in northern Minnesota. Her field knowledge in natural resources has landed her on several boards and special committees such Conservation Minnesota, the Campaign for Conservation, Belwin and of course, The International Wolf Center.
