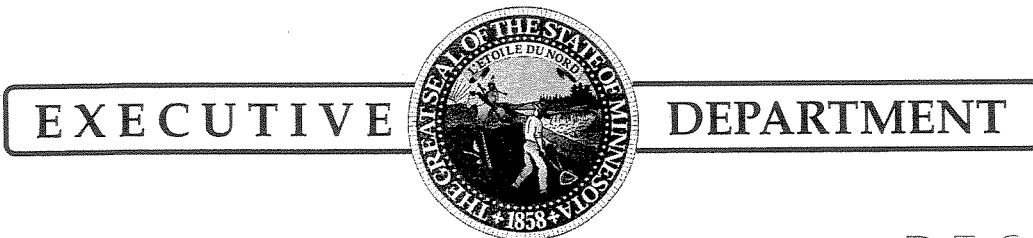



My name is Mike Gormley and I am the Sheriff of Faribault County. I was recently asked by Scott Reiten, with the Minnesota South Central region- EMS Joint Powers Board, if I would be interested in submitting an application to sit on the EMS Regulatory Board.

Since I was elected Sheriff in 2006, my office staff and I have been actively working with all of Faribault County's ambulance services as well as with the fire departments. We have worked together to build stronger county wide associations to accomplish better training and to address the issues of rural volunteer services. As well as being the Sheriff, I am a member of Bricelyn Fire and Ambulance Service. Serving in this capacity, has given me a working understanding of the issues such as limited manpower, affordable quality training, spematic communications coverage, as well as many other issues.
