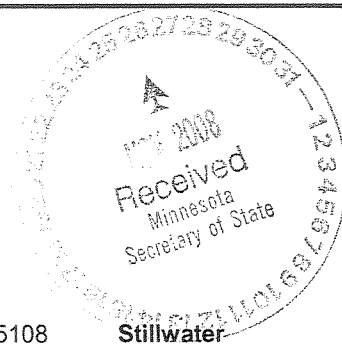

 DATE: November 21, 2008 I wish to be considered for a second term of membership on the Governor's Clean Water Council as the University of Minnesota/Higher Educational System representative. I have served in this capacity for the last two years. I am the Co-Director of the University of Minnesota's Water Resources Center, which promotes research, teaching, and outreach of water issues to the University and to the citizens of the State of Minnesota. In my capacity as Co-Director, I am well-acquainted with the US Clean Water Act, the Minnesota Clean Water Legacy Act, the activities and responsibilities of the Clean Water Council, and the issues surrounding the State's impaired waters. I was the representative of the University of Minnesota on the "G-40", the advisory group that provided stakeholder feedback to the "G-16" who crafted the Clean Water Legacy Act. I also served as Co-Chair the Science Advisory Panel for the complex Lake Pepin TMDL Study, and in this capacity coordinated a group of science experts who provided advice to the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency on scientific questions related to Lake Pepin impairments. I am a professor of environmental chemistry in the School of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health Sciences. My research interests and current projects are detailed in the attached Curriculum Vita. I have had considerable experience working with committees and councils in an advisory capacity. I have served on the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Science Advisory Board, and was just appointed Chair of this board last month. I also serve on the Science Advisory Board of the International Joint Commission of the US and Canada. I feel that my experience and perspective would be representative of higher education in the state and valuable to the Council. Thank you for considering me for this nomination.
