Ardell Brede has long been known for his deep interest in and appreciation for the arts-music, visual arts, dance, theater and arts education. Throughout his tenure as Mayor he has made visible and substantive contributions to the arts. He initiated Artstoberfest, an annual celebration of the arts in the month of October. The Avenue of the Arts was established and named in the City where there is the largest collection of arts institutions; a large scale painting hangs in the skyways across a busy street, the result of a contest involving many arts; when the Mayor does his mayoral medal of honor winners, there is a category of the arts where one or more citizens receives recognition from the Mayor of their achievements.

His achievements in the National League of Cities, the U.S. Conference of Mayors and the League of Minnesota Cities also reflect his interest in the arts. With the U.S. Conference he is an active member of the Tourism, Arts, Parks, Entertainment and Sports Committee. Through this committee he drafted a resolution that passed to Bring Back the Arts to New Orleans and urged cities to support this effort. The committees he serves on are indicative of the high appreciation he has for the arts. When New Orleans flooded, he sought new and nearly new band instruments to send to New Orleans for those who had lost their musical instruments in the flooding. He read a Minnesota poem on his visit to the city and received the deep and tearful appreciation from the recipients of the many instruments sent from Rochester.

He was the drving force behind the creation of the Rochester Council of the Arts, attends meetings of the Association of arts Administrators and is a financial supporter of local Arts groups through season ticket subscriptions and contributions.

Mayor Brede has served as a panel member of the State Arts Board in the past; he has a longtime deep interest in the University of Minnesota where he is called their number one fan; he has had a full career at Mayo Clinic/Rochester Methodiat Hospital as an administrator; he is a tireless advocate for his city and an active speaker. He was nominated by the Senate for a position in the Minnesota Regent Candidate Advisory Council where he serves yet today. He is a former Chair of the Rochester Arts Council, former president of Rochester Civic Music and active in the Chatfield brass band and has produced and sold watercolor paintings. He promoted the University of Minneosta 300-member Marching Band in bi-annual concerts in Rochester for over 20 years.
