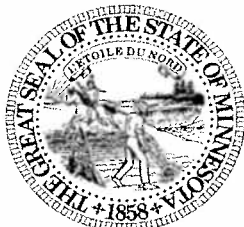

I am pleased to submit this application for the Metropolitan Council District #6. It has been my privilege to serve as the District #6 representative for the past two years. I am currently a member of the Transportation Committee and a member (Chair) of the Management Committee. The Met Council serves an important role in the region coordinating land use planning in a variety of areas, including transportation, wastewater services, parks and open space, housing and aviation. In addition, the Council manages wastewater and transit services for the region in an effective and efficient manner. The Council is currently in the process of developing Thrive MSP 2040, the 30 year plan for the region. In addition to the systems already under the purview of the Council, we are considering options to assist in economic development efforts, a housing plan that provides a variety of options to all residents, a long term water supply plan and the completion of a 21st century transit system. The Council should continue the "regulatory role" of compliance with Systems Statements. The Council should also develop strategies, along with the appropriate incentives, that results in minimizing disparities among neighborhoods and communities. One set of policies may not apply to all areas of the region and the Council must be creative and flexible enough to meet any unique situations. Thank you for your consideration.

He has served in a full-time management role for four cities: as a City Manager in St. Louis Park, Minnesota 1980-1988; Worthington, Ohio 1974-1980 and Wood Dale, Illinois 1971-1974, and as Assistant City Manager in Park Ridge, Illinois 1968-1971. He has a Master's Degree in Public Administration from Northern Illinois University (1968) and a B.A. Degree from Loras College (1963) in Dubuque, Iowa. Since November, 2008 he has served as the Administrator (part-time) in Spring Park, MN and completed that assignment in August, 2011.
Business Management

After twenty years in public sector management, Jim began an executive search career in 1988. In 1992 he established The Brimeyer Group, Inc., an executive search firm serving cities, counties, non-profit organizations, semi-public agencies and private sector companies.

In addition, Jim serves as a facilitator for public and private sector organizations for strategic planning, team building, goal setting, and board governance at both a policy-making and administrative staff level.

In 2009 Jim formed the Skyehill Governance Consulting organization and facilitates strategic planning, goal setting and governance sessions.

Memberships and Community Service

Jim is a member of the International City Management Association and the Minnesota City Management Association. He is active in the community as a Past President of the St Louis Park Rotary Club and the St. Louis Park Rotary Foundation. He has served as Chair, currently Treasurer, of the St Louis Park Community Foundation, is a member and former Board member at Minnesota Valley Golf Club and past President of the Skyehill Townhome Association.

Elected/Appointed Public Service

Jim served as City Council Member at-large in St. Louis Park, Minnesota for eight years (1996 - 2003). In 2005 he served for six months as Fourth Ward Council Member, completing an unexpired term. In 1994-95 he chaired the first Vision St Louis Park process and in 2005-2006 he again served as Chair of the Steering Committee for Vision St Louis Park, resulting in the publication of the Book of Dreams for St Louis Park.

From initiation until the end of 2009 he served as a member of the Policy Advisory Committee for the Southwest Corridor Transit Study and in December of 2010 was recognized by the St Louis Park City Council for his service on that project.

In March, 2011 Jim was appointed to the Metropolitan Council to serve in District #6, which serves Southwest Minneapolis, St Louis Park, Golden Valley, New Hope and Crystal. He serves as Chair of the Management Committee and is a member of the Transportation Committee.
