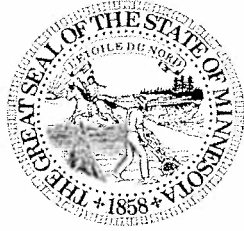



I would like to be appointed to the Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board in the Professional Firefighter Member position. I suspect you'll find very few candidates with a background such as mine: a professional firefighter, paramedic, wildland firefighter, community college instructor, AHA instructor, and hazmat technician.

As you'll see on the following resume, the depth of my experience in EMS and firefighting is broad. I was a certified EMT-Basic who volunteered for two years on a small town ambulance service that loved the job so much, I decided to further my education and become a paramedic. I spent five years working as a paramedic for a private ambulance service. I have also been a member of the Duluth Fire Department for six years, recently promoting to fire equipment operator, and am an active union member in the Duluth Firefighters' Local 101. Having worked as a wildland firefighter for the MN DNR for over 8 years and for a private wildland company for 3 years, allows another degree of experience as a firefighter and first responder.

I received a Bachelor's of Science degree from the University of Minnesota Duluth's Chemistry Department and went on to obtain a Master's Degree in Public Safety Executive Leadership from St. Cloud State. I am currently an adjunct EMS and Fire instructor at Lake Superior College in Duluth, MN. I also have experience as a first aid/CPR/AED/hazmat instructor for a private company in Duluth, MN. I have the background and experience to make decisions that are effective and relevant to EMS in Minnesota. I grew up in a small, rural town in northern Minnesota with parents that were EMT-Basic/Volunteer Firefighters; however, it is this fact that allows me to offer you such an unusual perspective on rural EMS.

I have spent the last four years representing professional firefighters on the EMSRB and would like to serve another four year term. I look forward to hearing from you.
