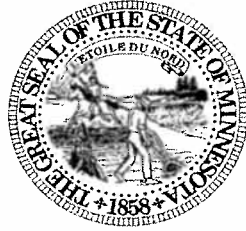

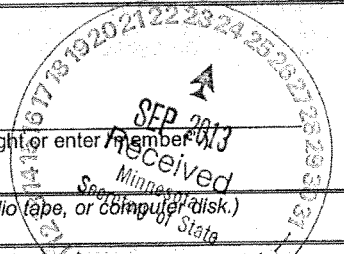


Dear Governor Dayton,

Biography

Marie McCarthy has made a lifelong commitment to serving her community through political action and volunteer service. Her work in politics has helped the poor and disenfranchised through her community organizing approach to political advocacy.

As Legislative Assistant to State Senator Alice Johnson, Marie is skilled at communicating effectively with constituents and local government units. She understands the role of government on a variety of policy issues that affect the citizens of the district and region. Marie organizes community forums and meets with municipal government leaders at the Senator's direction. She assists in assessing and prioritizing legislative issues that are relevant and important to the district and regional needs.

Marie has many years of experience in political consulting and training. She was a campaign consultant in various states and races for US Senate, US Congress, State Legislature, and Mayor. She is experienced in developing plans, strategy, communication, and field work.

While working with the National Association of Letter Carriers in Washington DC, she developed and implemented a nationwide training program that educated, activated and organized membership into political action. Due to changes in the Hatch Act, their membership was no longer restricted from political activism. She trained members in an eleven state region.

As part of the original team of Air America Minnesota, Marie helped establish a brand new market in talk radio. As Vice President of Sales and Marketing she expanded the sales base by creating new shows and programming and marketed it to potential clients. This partnership with business served both the station's mission and the client's interest in growing their market share and profits.
