1990 to Present: Chief Plumbing Inspector, Rochester Building and Safety, Rochester Minnesota—Check and review plans for code compliance, and recommend issuance or denial of permits. Consult with and advise engineers, contractors, and other involved parties of ordinances, and codes. Investigate complaints in regard to defective construction. Prosecute violators of the city or state codes. Inspect new and existing plumbing installations for code compliance. Direct the activities and work assignments of subordinate inspectors, (until ordinance change in 2003). Consult with supervisors on procedures to be followed in cases that are not clearly covered by existing regulations.

1988 to 1994: Teaching journeyman backflow prevention classes for State of Minnesota, certification and licensing.
