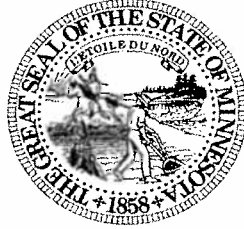



As a 2002 alumnus of the Perpich Center, and a 2010 graduate of the Minneapolis College of Art and Design (MCAD), founder and head of the ScatterBrain Studios artist studio co-op, and a professional full-time artist for the past three years; I feel I am well qualified to understand the needs, and requirements of young artists and creative individuals they require to develop their full potential

Having been raised in the small rural community of Waverly, the Perpich Center was not only my first to the world of fine art, but also my first interaction with artistically minded peers and access to the Minneapolis area art museums and creative culture. Perpich was pivotal in my development as an artist and as an individual. Without the Perpich Center, I would never have thought it was possible to become a professional artist, nor would I currently have the skills and ambition, which allowed that opportunity.

The Perpich Center showed me the importance of having a strong creative community where ideas and concepts could openly be discussed. Students from varying disciplines would naturally befriend each other, and allowed for the cross-pollination of ideas and insights, allowing for a richer and more creatively beneficial experience.
