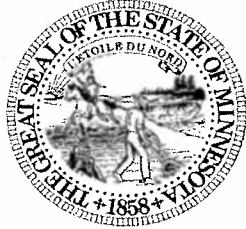




Victoria Reinhardt recently finished her second tour as Chair of the Ramsey County Board of Commissioners. She is a nationally recognized leader on environmental issues and has testified before Congress about local government collaboration. Victoria was first elected to the Ramsey County Board in 1996. Her work at Ramsey County has a common theme, decrease departmental boundaries and shift focus to reward long-term outcomes. In 2000 she was named one of the 25 Most Innovative Women in the Twin Cities by CityBusiness. In May of 2007 Victoria received her Doctorate in Public Administration from Hamline University for her work on calculating the taxpayer cost savings from juvenile crime prevention programs.
