Thank you for your time in my consideration as a Board member, I would be happy to answer any questions you may have of my application.





I am writing to inform you that I am actively seeking the position of Director of Community Services for Forest Lake Area Schools.

As the Director of Community Education for the Chisago Lakes School District, I have had the opportunity to provide leadership for the development and expansion of the Community Education program. I have also had the privilege of responding to many administrative challenges that the district has required of me, such as Chairing Countywide collaboration, grant writing, referendum planning and technology development.

Since coming to Chisago Lakes I have been involved in the planning, direction and operational leadership for the implementation of the following program areas: after-school adventure program, facility-use management, youth enrichment, adult basic education, distance learning project, targeted services program and preschool.

My career in Community Education began in 1981 as a Community Education employee in the South Washington County School System, ISD #833. I was involved in the development and implementation of many program areas and was directly responsible for facility-use management, the junior high activities program, summer enrichment programs, elementary intramurals, and district wide aquatics programming. I also served on a number of study teams involved with referendums and construction.

Upon completion of my Master's Degree in Community Education in May 1990, I accepted a position as Director of Community Education in Storm Lake, Iowa. In this position, I had the opportunity to develop a complete Community Education program from the ground up. The challenge of establishing a new program provided me with a unique experience that was not readily available in Minnesota. For further career development; I participated in the Community Education Leadership program conducted at the National Community Education Center in Flint, Michigan. While in Iowa, I was also voted to the Board of Directors for the Iowa Community Education Association, a responsibility that required my efforts in working on statewide policy and issues.

With the goal to work in a larger school system and return to Minnesota, I was hired by Chisago Lakes to take a small program and enhance and expand it. Since 1992 we have increased our programming from four areas of focus to fourteen areas. Expanding staff from 3 FTE's to 8 FTE's and numerous part-time employees. The results have been a 300% increase in participation within our programs and activities. I also had opportunities in providing leadership in referendum work, building construction projects, development of the Chisago Lakes Family Center, working with the County on the family collaborative projects and assisting in the combination of two school districts (Chisago Lakes and Taylors Falls) in to one.

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I pursued a new challenge in 1996 by becoming the Manager of Operations of the executive office for the Minnesota Community Education Association. This unique experience has provided me a whole new insight to Community Education statewide and has allow me to hone my management skills at a new level. I am responsible to the MCEA Board of directors and membership, a membership comprised of many of my peers. I believe in the past Nine years I have developed many new contacts and have expanded a network of peers, both in the metro area as well as in greater Minnesota.

Education in the state of Minnesota is in a great deal of flux and the services that a local Community Education program provided just a couple of years ago may not be the services that the public will want in the future. The continued growth and success of the local Community Education program lies in the ability of the staff, advisory council and administration to adapt to the many changes that constantly occur and adjust the services to meet those changes.

With a genuine concern for others and a philosophy that strong human relation skills are essential in dealing with the diverse personalities present in every professional staff, I believe in team management and group decision-making. Collaboration leads to empowerment, ownership, and finally commitment.

My sound educational preparation combined with my twenty four years of practical experience in Community Education, make me a strong candidate for the Director of Community Services position in the Forest Lake Area School District. I am well-organized and use common sense in working with people. I have a high energy level, good sense of humor, thrive on challenge, creative problem solving and welcome change.
