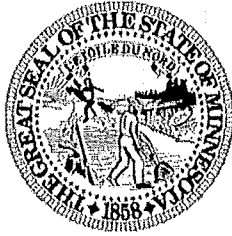


In my full-time position as Executive Director of the Lake Pepin Legacy Alliance, I coordinate between diverse stakeholders to ensure the vitality of Lake Pepin as an integral part of a multi-use river. This includes balancing ecosystem protection and improvement with commercial and recreational navigation, public access to the lake, and the lake's significance as a social and cultural resource.

As part of an effort to see a large-scale habitat improvement project come to fruition on Lake Pepin, I have worked closely with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the Minnesota and Wisconsin Departments of Natural Resources to identify and leverage funding sources, set project objectives, and ensure the public and Lake Pepin's adjacent municipalities were (and continue to be) engaged in the planning process. As a result, we were able to incorporate local objectives (improved public access) into the broader project goals. Finding opportunities for innovation and more robust benefits within the constraints of federal and state programs is one of my driving motivators.

In my position on the Clean Water Council and through my board service on the Minnesota Environmental Fund and Minnesota Conservation Federation, I've developed a clear understanding of Minnesota's environmental goals and how they are prioritized among other state interests. These are challenging and complex decisions that rarely have an obvious answer. I believe my ability to "see the forest through the trees" without diminishing the significance of crucial policy details will add value to the decision-making process on the Environmental Quality Board.

I greatly appreciate the consideration of my application and I hope I can bring my perspective to this board.
