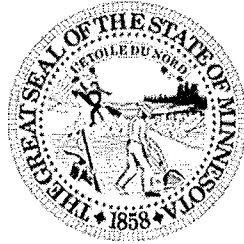

I have volunteered at spaces that protect votes and educate immigrant communities about why voting is significant. I am motivated, passionate, and enthusiastic about helping undocumented immigrants, housing crises, and ending food insecurity. This position would allow me to enhance my previous advocacy and policy work to push for policies that affect marginalized people like myself in MN.

I currently serve as the Student Body Vice President at Minnesota State University, Mankato. Where I have been advocating and creating resolutions to help and support my fellow students, for example, changing the lincoln lounge to the Dakota Lounge to make a more inclusive space for Native American students and community members while also moving the prayer room outside of the hallway and into a private room on campus to help students feel safe and secure to pray privately. I have served on several committees, including the President's Commission on Diversity, President's Commissions on Women's Status, and the Bias Committee. Where I advocate for local and state levels in young girls' needs such as menstrual equity bills. I also serve as a Fellow at Students United, working on initiatives like tuition freeze, food insecurity, and mental health resources. I have advocated and met with legislatures to push for these initiatives to increase resources for students to succeed in college.

This Position would further my educational goals about how to advocate the things that I'm passionate about such as the policies that affect students especially, BIPOC students. This position will further my passion to be the voice of immigrants, women, Muslim, black, and First-Gen students whose voice is often forgotten.
