Note: beginning in FY22, SF 3870 restricts the amount of revenue from Xcel Energy to the Renewable Development Account to \$16m/year minus the amount of Xcel's annual Solar Rewards grant obligations if either the Prairie Island or Monticello nuclear power plants are in operation, plus \$7.5m/year if the Prairie Island plant is not in operation and \$5.25m/year if the Monticello plant is not in operation. If both plants are not in operation, this amount is limited to \$12.75m/year minus the Solar Rewards grant obligations.
