- (1) House numbers reflect the S4563A1 amendment which was posted for a Ways and Means Committee meeting, but was not acted upon when the bill was removed from the agenda.
- (2) HF 1507, appropriates \$50 million from the general fund, but if MMB commissioner determines the expenses are eligible for the coronavirus relief fund, the appropriations are made from the CRF.
- (3) SF 4494, appropriates \$20M from the general fund, but if MMB commissioner determines the expenses are eligible for the coronavirus relief fund, the appropriations are made from the CRF.
- (4) HF 1507, appropriates \$27 million from the general fund for Broadband, but if MMB commissioner determines the expenses are eligible for the coronavirus relief fund, the appropriations are made from the CRF.
- (5) SF 4495, appropriates \$30 million from the general fund for Housing Assistance Grants, but if MMB commissioner determines the expenses are eligible for the coronavirus relief fund, the appropriations are made from the CRF. SF 4495 was not acted upon by the full Senate. The Senate acted upon HF 2542 which appropriated \$100M from the CRF.
- (6) HF 1507, appropriates \$100 million from the general fund for Housing Assistance Grants, but if MMB commissioner determines the expenses are eligible for the coronavirus relief fund, the appropriations are made from the CRF.
