S.F. No. 104 – Technical Change to Identity Theft Crime

SF No. 104 amends the penalty subdivision of the identity theft crime to separate two of the crimes. Under current law, identity theft involving eight or more direct victims or a combined, total loss to all victims of more than \$35,000 appears in the same numbered clause as identity theft related to child pornography (regardless of the number of victims or total loss). Both crimes have the same maximum penalty (20 years imprisonment and/or a \$100,000 fine via a cross-reference to the theft law's sentencing provision). The bill separates these offenses into two different numbered clauses. The penalty levels are not changed.
