## S.F. No. 1197 – Prohibiting Public Dissemination of a Law Enforcement Official’s Home Address

### Section 1. Dissemination of Personal Information About Law Enforcement Prohibited; Penalty.

**Subdivision 1. Definitions.** Defines terms for the purposes of the bill.

**Subdivision 2. Crime Described.** Creates a misdemeanor for a person to knowingly and without consent make publicly available personal information about a law enforcement official or an official’s family or household member if:

- the dissemination poses an imminent and serious threat to the official’s safety; and
- the person making the information publicly available knows or reasonably should know of the imminent and serious threat.

The bill is effective August 1, 2021, and applies to crimes committed on or after that date.
