## **S.F. No. 130 – Crime Alert Categories to Include Dementia and Alzheimer’s Disease; Appropriating Money**

The bill appropriates \$600,000 in fiscal year 2023 and \$600,000 in fiscal year 2024 from the general fund to the Commissioner of Public Safety the following purposes.

\$400,000 each year for regional and statewide voluntary training grants to state and local law enforcement officials and first responders for training on communication strategies, behavioral studies, and other issues associated with persons with dementia and Alzheimer’s disease. Requires the commissioner to submit a report to the Legislature by January 1, 2024, that describes and evaluates the grant program.

\$200,000 each year for the criminal alert network to increase membership, reduce the registration fee, and create additional alert categories, including at a minimum a dementia and Alzheimer’s disease specific category.

The bill is effective the day following final enactment.
