**Section 1. Compensation for members of the Minnesota State Patrol.** When the commissioner of management and budget negotiates a collective bargaining agreement that establishes State Patrol trooper salaries, the commissioner must consider compensation for the troopers based on the legislative auditor’s most recent salary and benefit survey. Using pattern bargaining or internal equity data constitutes bad faith in negotiations.

**Section 2. Appropriations; Department of Public Safety; State Patrol.** This section pays for ongoing costs of the 8.4% salary increase for state patrol troopers that was authorized in the 5<sup>th</sup> special session in 2020.

**Section 3. State Patrol Trooper Salary Increase.** This section provides an 8.4% increase to state patrol supervisory and managerial positions. This section is effective the day following final enactment.

**Section 4. Appropriations.** This section appropriates money for the remainder of fiscal year 2021 for the raises provided in **section 3**.
