S.F. No. 1331 amends provisions relating to the Minnesota Family Investment Program and the Diversionary Work Program to enable applicants to submit applications by telephone or online in addition to submitting a physical application, to authorize assistance to begin on the date that the application is submitted, to permit applicant interviews to be conducted by telephone, and to require a signed application to be submitted within 30 days of an application submitted by telephone or online. Section 3 also eliminates the requirement for MFIP caregiver orientation must be face-to-face.
