The Legislative Commission on Data Practices and Personal Data Privacy was established in 2014 but expired in 2019. Yet, statutes still required the submission of data audit reports related to automated license plate readers and portable recording systems (“body cameras”) to be submitted to the commission. **S.F. 1614** removes the specific reference to the commission and clarifies that the data audit reports must be submitted to the legislative committees with jurisdiction over public safety and data practices.

Effective date. This bill is effective the day following final enactment.
