Section 1 [Display of Business Address on Website] permits certain business entities to have their addresses omitted from display on the Secretary of State website. This option is available to a business that has only one shareholder, member, manager, or owner, who is a natural person and uses a residential address for that person as one of its business addresses. Requires the secretary of state to post a notice on its website about this option and to attach the request form to all business filing forms requiring an address that are provided in paper format. This section does not alter the classification of this data, and addresses must be made available to the public in response to requests for data.
