**S.F. 1979** requires the commissioner of public safety to establish a minimum of 93 locations where a person may take a driver’s license knowledge test, road test, or both. The 93 specified locations were in operation on March 1, 2020. The commissioner must offer the same services at these locations on the same number of days and the same number of hours that were offered on March 1, 2020. This section does not prohibit the commissioner from opening additional testing locations or expanding services at any of the named locations.
