S.F. No. 2001 – Requiring Campus Mental Health Services, Training, and Information

Section 1 (136F.20, subd. 4) amends the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities chapter of law, specifically the section related to student health, by adding a subdivision requiring the board to implement a mental health awareness program at each community and technical college by fall of 2022. This section lists the seven components for which the program must include.

Section 2 appropriates \$250,000 per year for purposes of section 1. The Board of Trustees shall convene a committee to review and approve grant applications and a majority of the committee's membership must be students appointed by the statewide student association.
