S.F. No. 269 requires the commissioner of human services to contract with a consultant in order to develop a proposal that would implement a risk-based model for monitoring and enforcing child care licensing compliance. The consultant must engage with relevant stakeholders and solicit input on how to develop the risk-based compliance system. The commissioner’s report and proposed legislation based on the consultant’s work must be submitted to the legislature by February 1, 2024. The proposal includes a onetime appropriation of \$1,500,000 available until June 30, 2024, to fund the project.
