S.F. No. 297 would establish the Human Services Background Study Disqualification Review Task Force, consisting of 14 members representing interested or affected populations, that would review the statutes relating to human services background study disqualifications in order to evaluate their effectiveness, strengths and weaknesses, unintended consequences, or other areas for improvement or modernization. The task force would develop legislative proposals to address issues it identifies following its review. The task force would meet at least monthly, beginning July 1, 2021, and would submit a report of its findings and draft legislation by February 11, 2022. The proposal includes a fillable onetime appropriation to fund the task force.
