**S.F. No. 429 – Election of Presidential Electors**

**S.F. 429** modifies how presidential electors are elected. Each major political party must nominate one presidential elector from each congressional district and two electors from the state at-large. The State Canvassing Board must prepare a statement with the total number of votes for each presidential candidate in each congressional district and statewide. The two at-large electors are elected based on which party received the highest number of votes statewide in the presidential race. Each elector that is representing a congressional district is elected based on which party received the highest number of votes in that district in the presidential race.
