S.F. No. 517 - Child care providers administrative law procedures modification – First Engrossment

S.F. No. 517 amends the effect of an administrative law judge decision relating to the license of a family or group family day care provider.

Section 1 (245A.08, subdivision 4) requires an administrative law judge to issue a final binding decision, rather than a recommendation to the commissioner of human services, following a hearing relating to the license of a family or group family day care provider. The decision may be appealed for judicial review in a district court.

Section 2 (245A.08, subdivision 5) makes a technical conforming change to the requirements for the commissioner to provide notice of a final order on a matter relating to licensed family or group family day care, because the commissioner would no longer issue such final orders
