**S.F. No. 544 – Revenue Recapture; Disallowing Claims from
Certain Hospitals**

SF 544 eliminates the ability for private nonprofit hospitals that lease buildings from the county or city in which it is located from using the revenue recapture program. The revenue recapture program allows the Minnesota Department of Revenue to take or recapture certain refunds and payments, including income and property tax refunds, certain lottery winnings, political contribution refunds, and SFIA payments, and apply them to debts owed to qualifying agencies. Qualifying agencies include state agencies, cities, counties, and district courts, city-owned and nonprofit hospitals that lease space from a city or county, licensed ambulance services, the University of Minnesota, and Minnesota State Colleges and Universities.

Effective the date following final enactment.
