S.F. No. 651 – In-Person Absentee Voting Polling Places

Under current law, in-person absentee voting (often referred to as early voting) polling places are at the office of the county auditor and any other polling places designated by the auditor. **S.F. 651** specifies that the additional polling places must: 1) be at a precinct polling place; and 2) be open for the entire in-person absentee voting period during the same days and hours that the county auditor's office is open for in-person absentee voting.
