S.F. No. 656 – Same-Day Driver’s License Pilot Project (As Amended by the A-3 Amendment)

S.F. 656, as amended by the **A-3 amendment**, requires the commissioner of public safety to conduct a same-day driver’s license pilot project in the city of Lakeville. The pilot project will require participating driver’s license agents to issue same-day noncompliant driver’s licenses, identification cards, and instruction permits. The commissioner of public safety must provide the necessary equipment to the driver’s license agents. The commissioner must submit a report to the legislature by January 1, 2023 about the pilot project. A blank appropriation is made to the commissioner of public safety for the costs of the equipment.
