S.F. No. 71 – Tribal and county reimbursement of costs for federal funds incorrectly claimed appropriations

S.F. No. 71 appropriates money to the commissioner of human services for payments to counties and tribes for costs relating to federal noncompliance or ineligibility.

Section 1 appropriates \$8,812,000 for county reimbursement for substance use disorder services provided in institutions for mental disease for which the costs were ineligible for federal funding.

Section 2 appropriates \$28,908,000 for grants of \$14,666,000 to the Leech Lake Band of Ojibwe and \$14,242,000 to the White Earth Band of Chippewa to repay overpayments for medication assisted treatment services between fiscal year 2014 and fiscal year 2019.
