S.F. No. 742 – Allowing Release of Crash Reports to Prosecuting Attorneys

Under current law, crash reports are only to be used by the commissioner of public safety or other government agencies for analyzing crashes. There are several exceptions to this rule that allow other entities to use crash reports for specified purposes.

S.F. 742 allows crash reports to be used by a prosecuting attorney for a traffic or criminal offense that is the result of a crash investigation conducted by law enforcement.
