

S.F. No. 939 – Postsecondary Enrollments Options Program (PSEO)

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Section 1. Authorization; career or technical education. Allows a 10th grade student that qualifies to enroll in a career or technical education course to enrolled in more than one course during their first semester of their 10th grade year.

Section 2. Dissemination of information; notification of intent to enroll. Allows a student to notify the district of their intent to enroll in PSEO courses after the May 30 deadline if the district does not meet the subdivision’s dissemination of information requirements.

Section 3. Enrollment priority. Allows a postsecondary institution to provide information about its programs on educational, programmatic, and financial grounds. Strikes obsolete language.

Section 4. Participation in high school activities. Clarifies that a student enrolled in PSEO may have leadership roles or participate in national organizations sponsored by their high school.

Section 5. Credits; grade point average weighting policy. Requires a school board to adopt an identical weighted grade point average policy for PSEO coursework and concurrent enrollment coursework.

Section 6. Transportation. Allows for a school district to be reimbursed for transporting eligible pupils between the secondary school or their home and the postsecondary institution. Prohibits the school district from charging the pupil for the transportation.

Section 7. Appropriation. Appropriates a blank amount for enrollment options transportation.
